






Witness rates (% often+always)


Frequency of incidents that happen to others








Frequency of incidents that happen to me






Perpetrator rates (% often+always)










Overall bullying rate: 3.7%


6 types of behaviour are used: kicking me, threatening to beat me up, making me give them money, trying to hurt me, trying to ruin something of mine, trying to hit me.


Incidents are noted if they have happened <u>more than once</u> over the past week.




















Size of Municipality





Survey of school principals: how they

(% often+always)








Summary

- The bullying rate is 3.7%.
- 11% of students-victims don't tell anyone.
- Percentages of peer harassment are higher among witnesses than victims or perpetrators.
- The primary perpetratos are "groups of boys" and most are in the same class as the victim.
- Bullying occurs mainly in class.
- Friends and family members intervene the most when harassment occurs.
- Boys are more often victims than girls.
- Students in their 1st or 2nd year of secondary education and repeating students suffer the most harassment.
- Bullying is less common in smaller municipalities.
