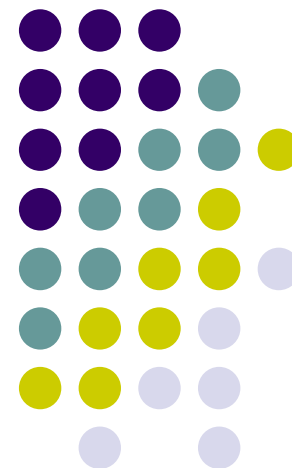

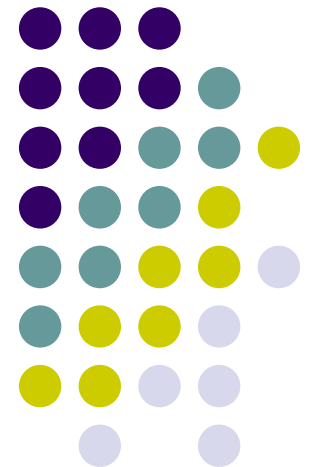

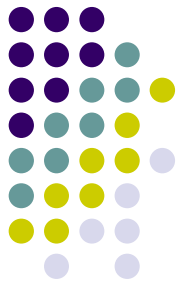


# Survey sample



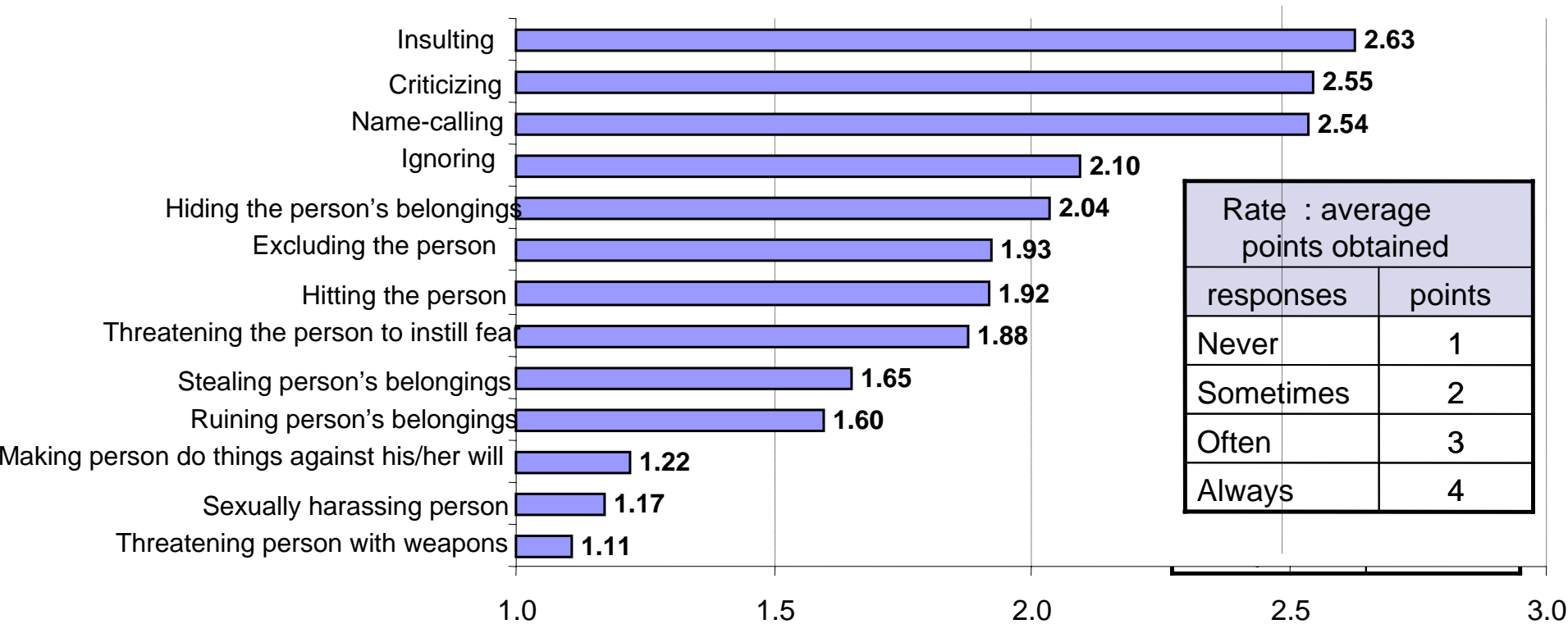
- Students: 3132

# Witness rates (% often+always)

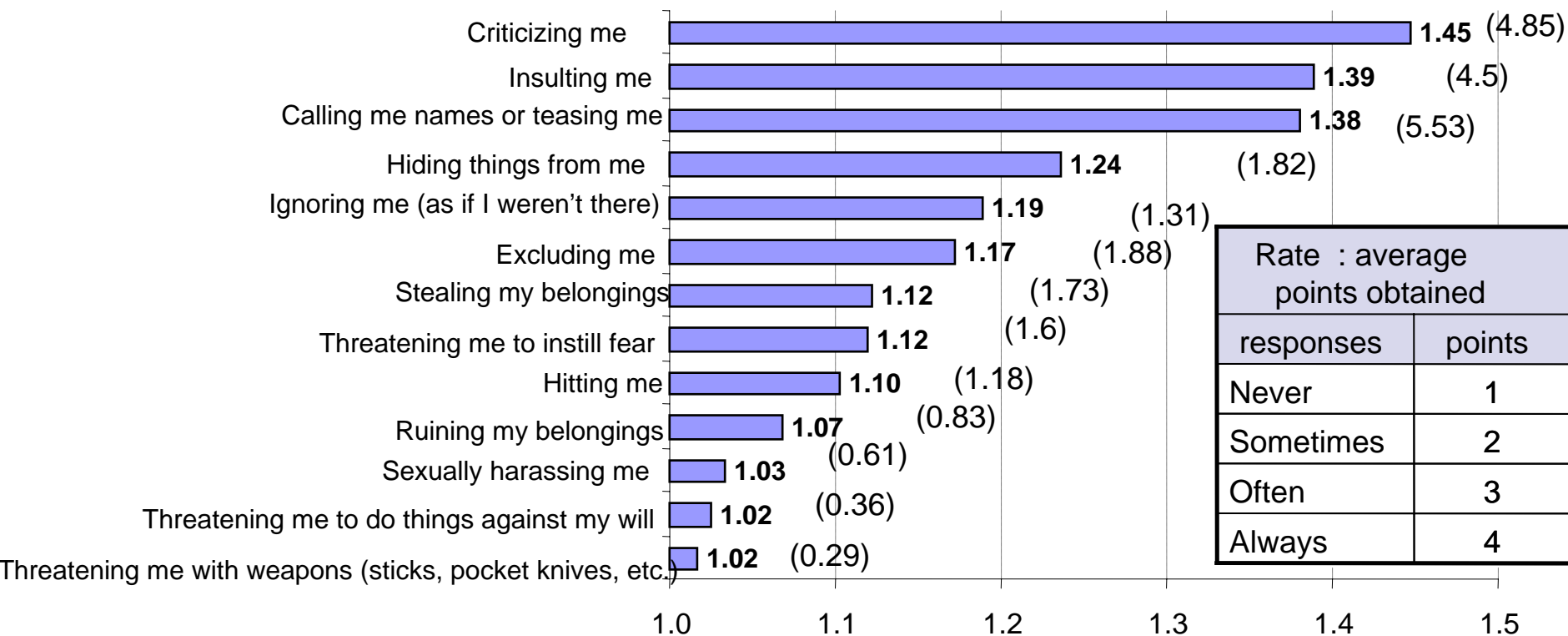
Frequency of incidents that happen to others

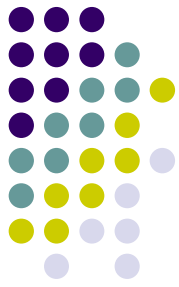


# Victim rates (% often+always)



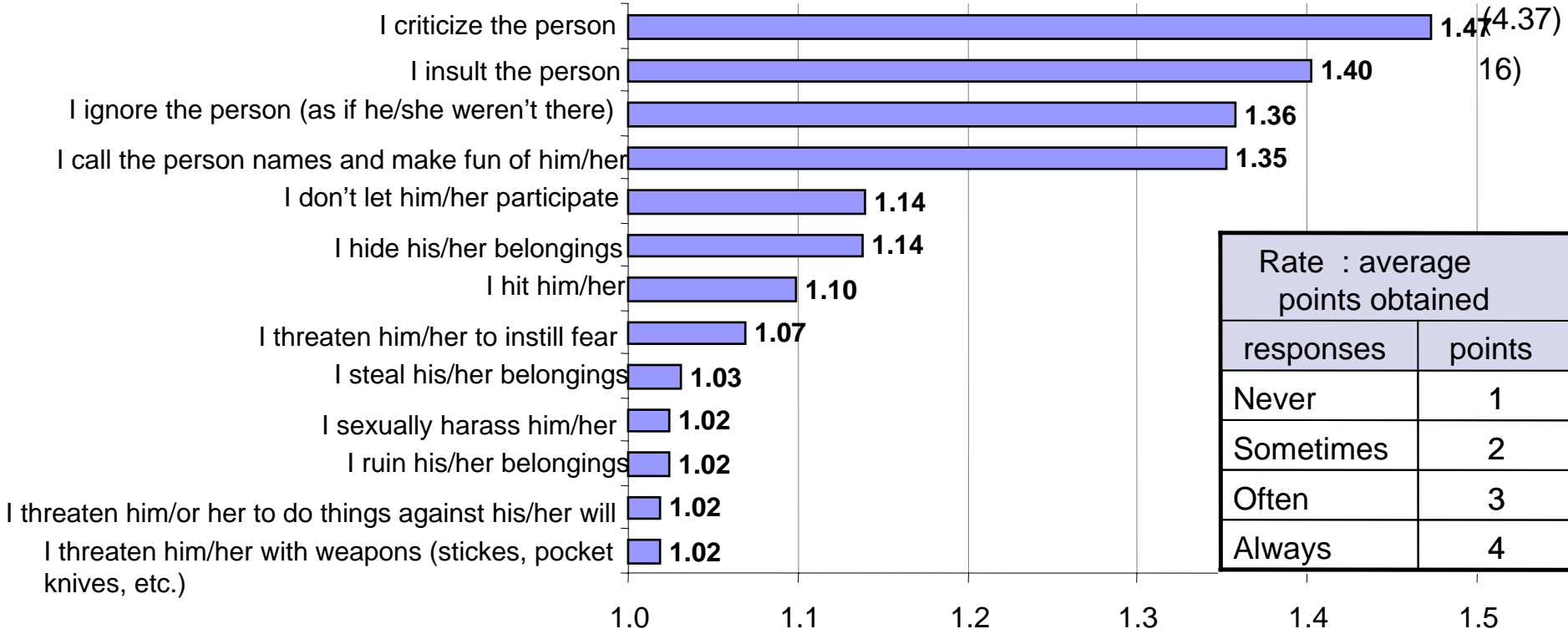
## Frequency of incidents that happen to me



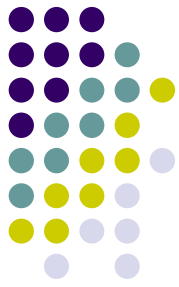


# Perpetrator rates (% often+always)

Frequency of incidents in which students take part



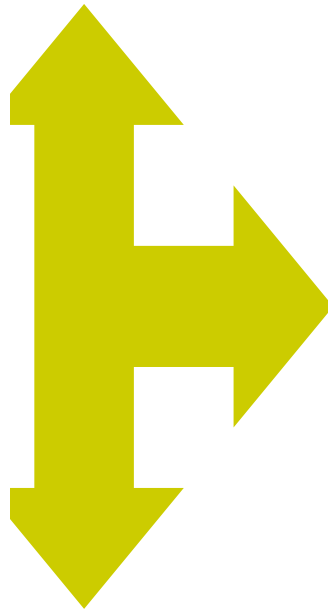

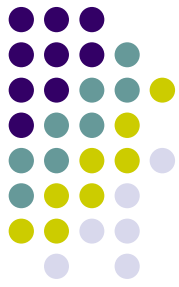

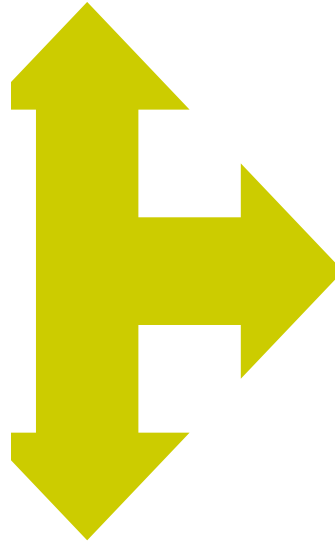

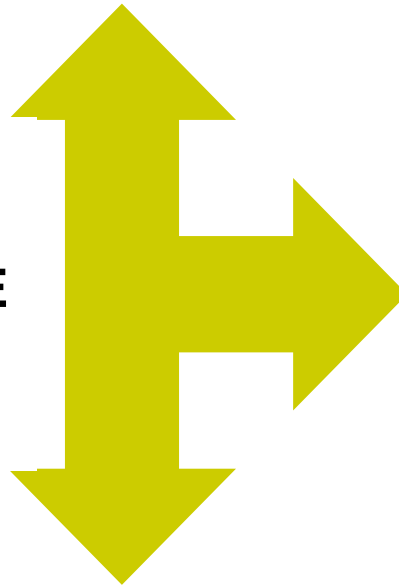

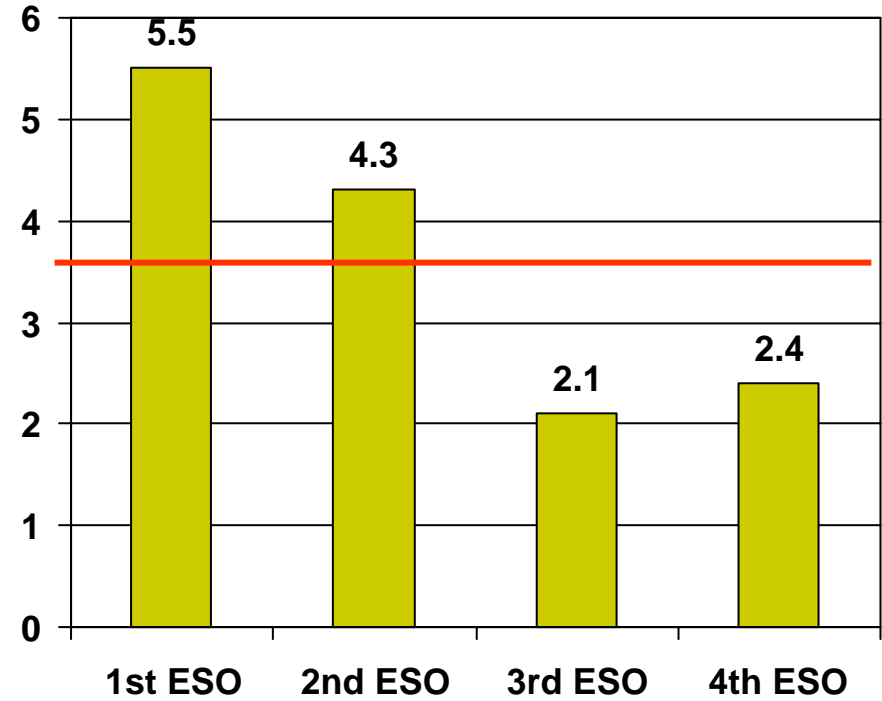
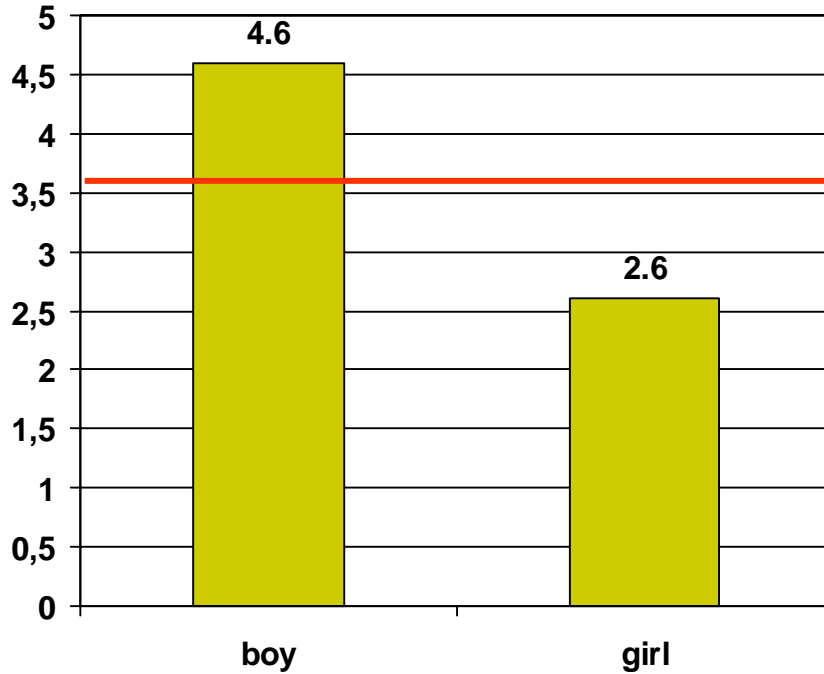
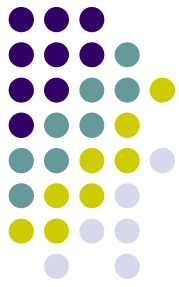
# Overall bullying rate: 3.7%

**6 types of behaviour are used: kicking me, threatening to beat me up, making me give them money, trying to hurt me, trying to ruin something of mine, trying to hit me.**

**Incidents are noted if they have happened more than once over the past week.**

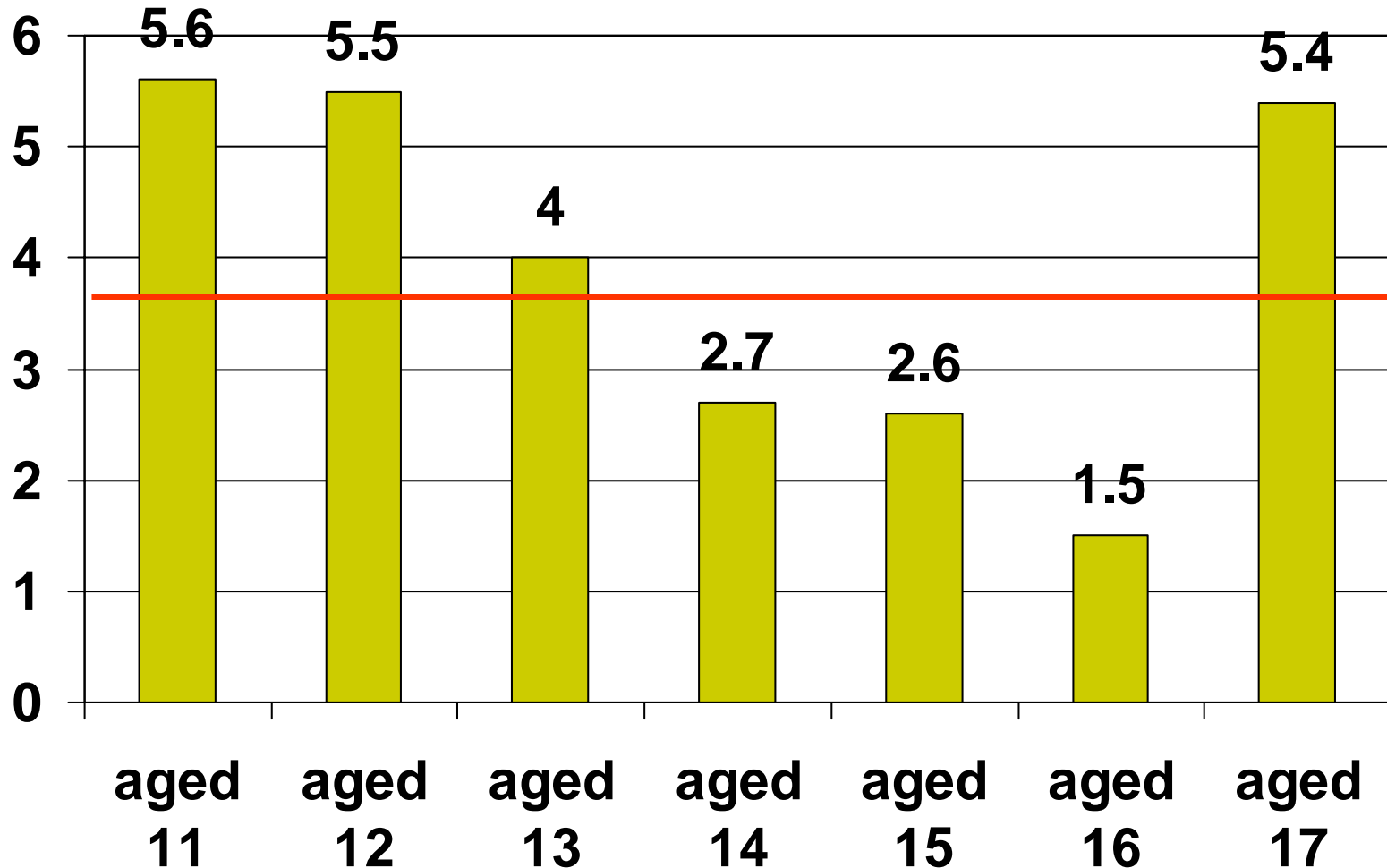

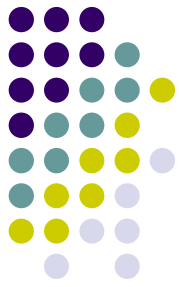




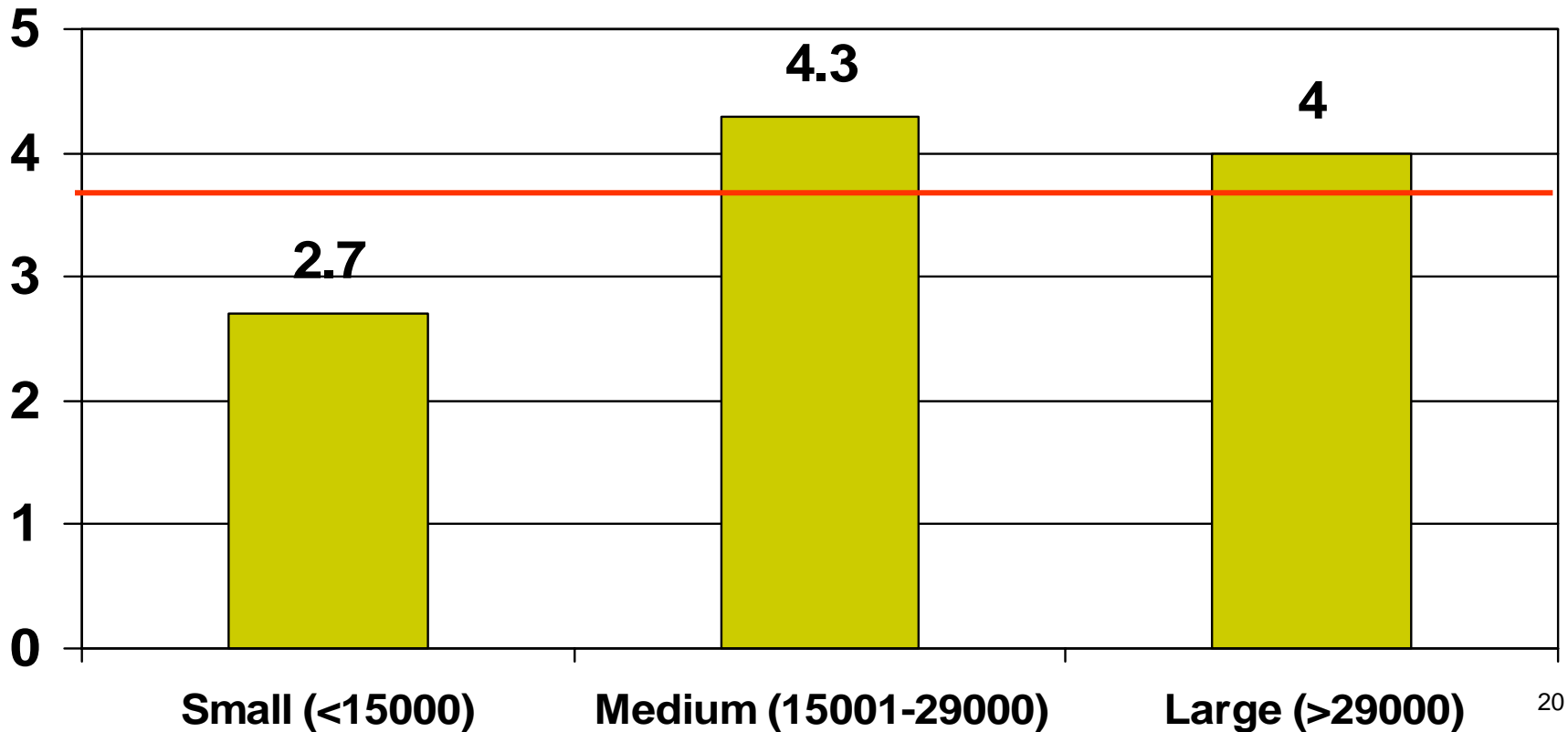

Size of Municipality

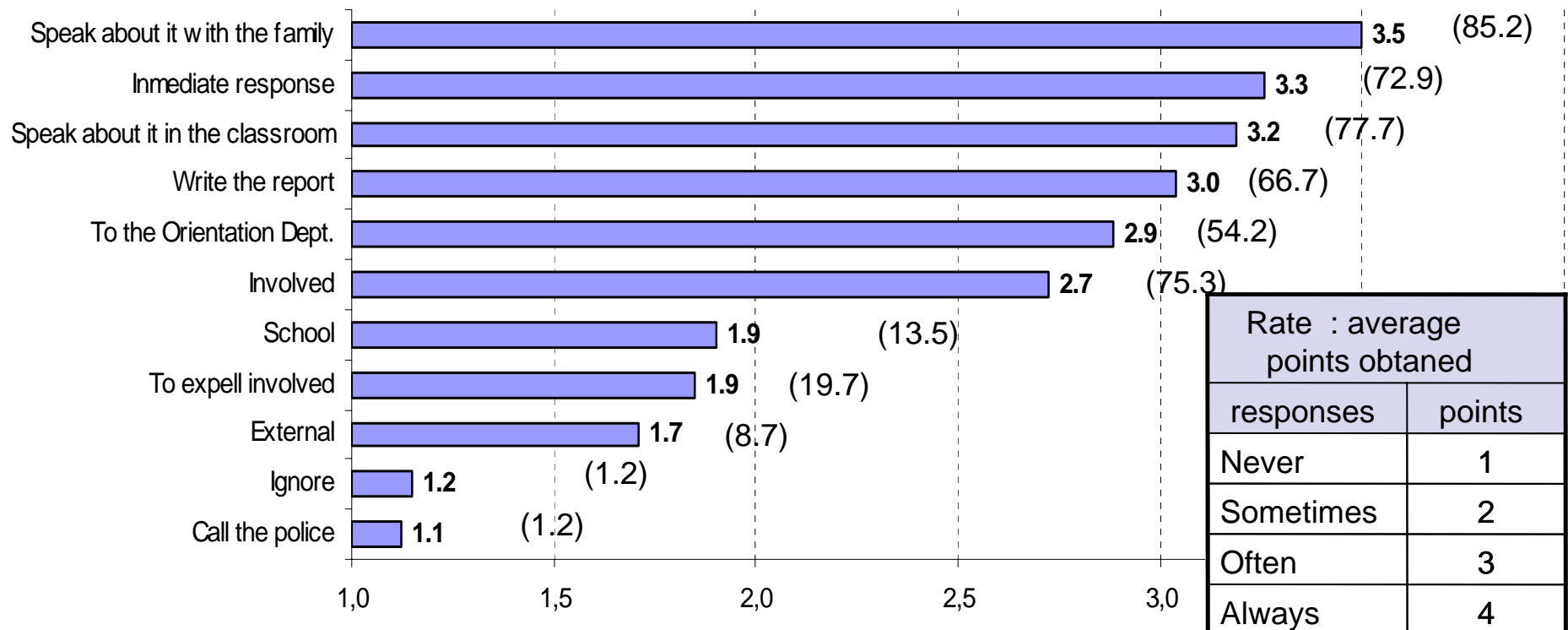




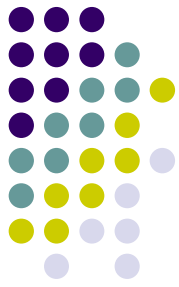
# Survey of school principals: how they react

# Summary

- The bullying rate is 3.7%.
- 11% of students-victims don't tell anyone.
- Percentages of peer harassment are higher among witnesses than victims or perpetrators.
- The primary perpetrators are “groups of boys” and most are in the same class as the victim.
- Bullying occurs mainly in class.
- Friends and family members intervene the most when harassment occurs.
- Boys are more often victims than girls.
- Students in their 1st or 2nd year of secondary education and repeating students suffer the most harassment.
- Bullying is less common in smaller municipalities.

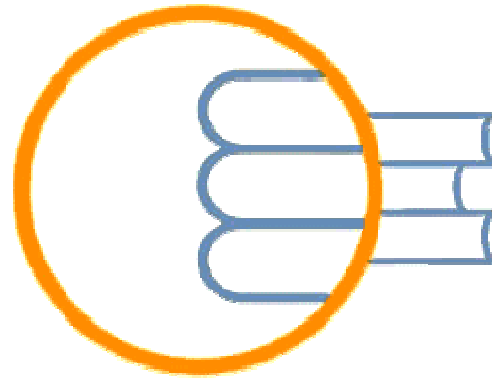
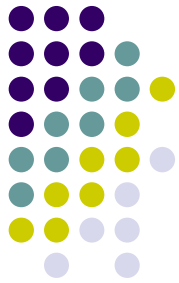
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
